**O'Neil Pass / Dan Crain Memorial RR – SD State Championship Road Race**  
**Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009 7:30a.m. to 2:00p.m.**  
**Spearfish Canyon – Spearfish, SD**

**BACKGROUND:**

The O'Neil Pass / Dan Crain Memorial RR started nearly 20 years ago and had been one of the premier road races in the area. Riders race through beautiful Spearfish Canyon, climb up and over O'Neil Pass and Aztec Hill before once again screaming through Spearfish Canyon to the finish. This year's addition of the race will also double as the South Dakota State Championship Road Race. Those who are citizens of South Dakota have the opportunity to fend for the State title in their respective categories.

**ROAD RACE REGISTRAION:**

- Riders must have USAC annual license OR purchase 1-day license.
- Citizens racers can race under 1-day USAC racing license.
- 1-day licenses will be available for purchase at race site (\$10.00).

**SOUTH DAKOTA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP ROAD RACE AWARDS:**

- Riders competing for the State Road Race must be a resident of SD and race and are only eligible for medals in their respective category.

**GENERAL ROAD RACE RULES & INFORMATION:**

- All 2009 USAC rules are in effect.
- Events will be held rain or shine.
- Race number placement will be posted the day of the event.
- Helmets must be worn at all times while on the bike.
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at rider check-in.
- Promoter reserves the right to cancel/combine events and prize lists as necessary.
- Prizes will only be awarded to top half of each category.
- Held under USAC Permit - pending.
- All events will be “wheels in/wheels out.” Please make sure to identify your wheels properly. Promoter is not responsible for lost or stolen wheels.
- **Center Line Rule will be STRICTLY Enforced.**

**DIRECTIONS:**

From I-90 take Exit 12 (Jackson Blvd) into Spearfish, SD. Off of exit head west and turn left onto Canyon Street. Spearfish City Park located on S. Canyon Street.

**COURSE DETAILS:**

72 MILE COURSE - Neutral roll-out starting at the city park on S. Canyon St. Proceeds to Spearfish Canyon, US Hwy 14A and take right turn. Proceed up Spearfish Canyon to intersection of 14A and US Hwy 85. Go right on Hwy 85 proceeding west to O’Neil Pass and over the pass to Trails Head Lodge which will be the first turn around point in the race route. Return to intersection of 85 and 14A stay straight and climb Aztec Hill on Hwy 85 to the top where the second turn around will be. Descend down Aztec with a right turn to re-enter Spearfish Canyon on hwy 14A. Once back in Spearfish Canyon riders will gradually descend back towards Spearfish. Finish Line will be a flat strait 1K drag to the line just before the town. Neutral feed zones at Trails Head Lodge and Aztec Hill turnarounds.

40 MILE COURSE - Neutral roll-out starting at the city park on S. Canyon St. Proceeds to Spearfish Canyon, US Hwy 14A and take right turn. Proceed up Spearfish Canyon to intersection of 14a and us Hwy 85, turn around and return to finish line prior to City Park.

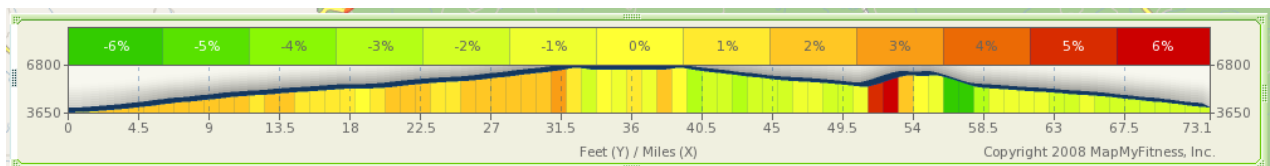
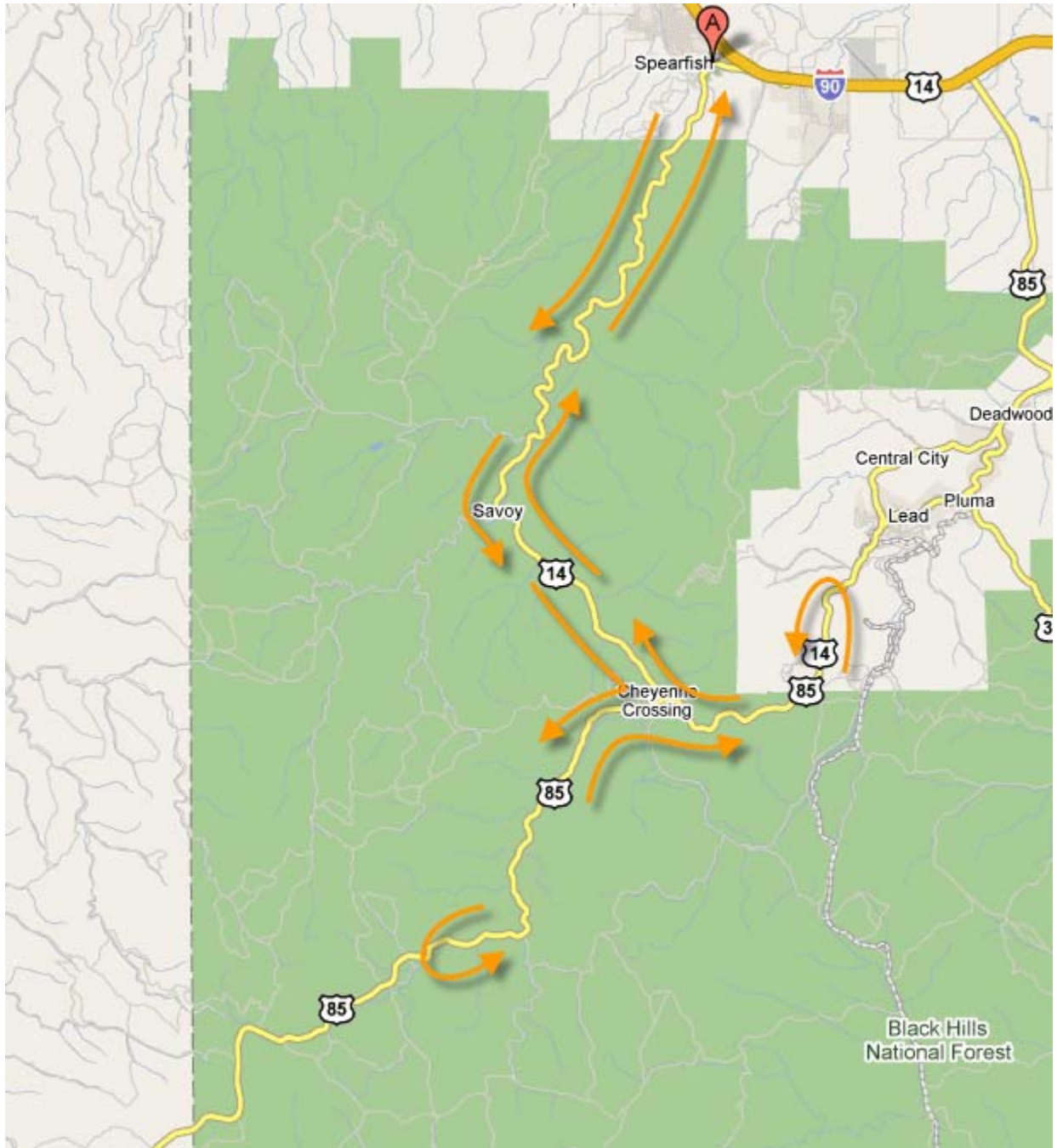

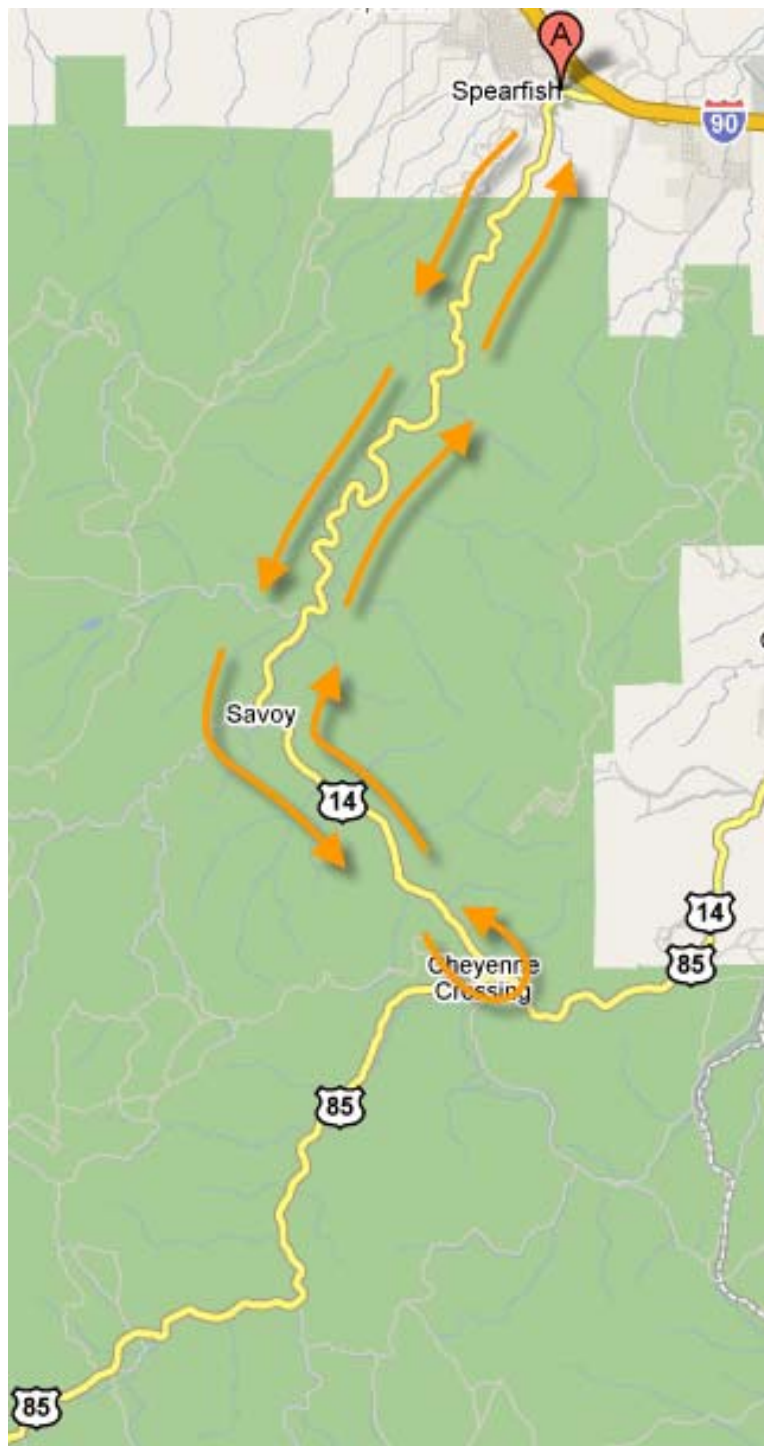

## Buffalo Jump TT – SD State Championship Time Trial

Sunday, August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2009 8:00a.m. to 1:00p.m.

Sand Creek Campground - Beulah, WY

### BACKGROUND:

In the ultimate test of fitness, racers will compete against the clock in the Buffalo Jump TT. The Buffalo Jump TT will also double as the South Dakota State Championship Time Trial. Those who are citizens of South Dakota have the opportunity to fend for the State title in their respective categories.

- **First Place winner in each Men's 1/2/3, Men 35+ Open, Women 1/2/3, Men 4, Men 45+ Open, Men 5, Women 4, Junior, and Men 55+ Open category to receive local artisan's handmade clay Dykstra Pottery.**

### REGISTRATION:

- Make checks payable to "**CPC**".
- Entry fee includes USAC \$3.00 surcharge.
- Riders must have USAC annual license OR purchase 1-day license.
- Citizens racers can race under 1-day USAC racing license.
- 1-day licenses will be available for purchase at race site (\$10.00).

### SOUTH DAKOTA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TIME TRIAL AWARDS:

- Riders competing for the State Time Trial must be a resident of SD and are only eligible in their respective category.

**GENERAL TIME TRIAL RULES & INFORMATION:**

- All 2009 USAC rules are in effect.
- Time Trial will be held rain or shine.
- Race number placement will be posted the day of the event.
- Helmets must be worn at all times while on the bike.
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at rider check-in.
- Promoter reserves the right to cancel/combine events and prize lists as necessary.
- Prizes will only be awarded to top half of each category.
- Held under USAC Permit - pending.
- No warming up on course while time trials are in progress.

**DIRECTIONS:**

From Spearfish take I-90 west until exiting at Beulah, WY at Exit 206. Proceed West into Beulah on old Hwy 14. Registration and parking at Sand Creek Campground on right hand side of road.

**COURSE DETAILS:**

From Beulah, racers head west on old hwy 14 to 5 mile mark before turning around and heading back to the finish line in Beulah. The course is 5 miles of rolling terrain gradually ascending on way out and then descending on way back to the finish line.

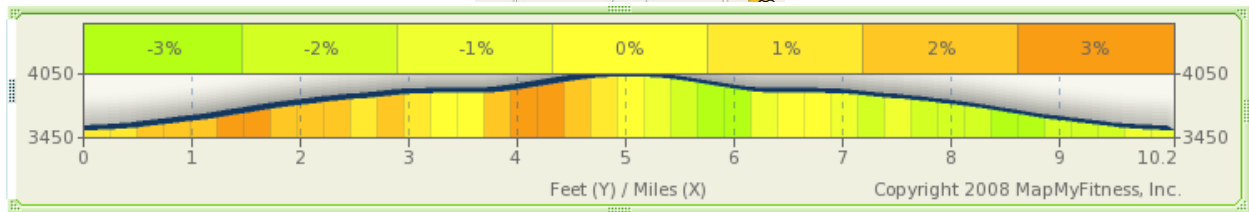
